

College has been granted Autonomous status from the Academic year 2024-25 for 10 years. Board of Studies and Academic Council committees are formed to prepare and approve curriculum contents. Curricular framework is in line with NEP 2020.

Institute follows a continuous evaluation scheme. In the beginning of the semester, after subject allotment is done, each faculty decides the Course Outcomes of his/her course and formulates various assessment tools to achieve the outcomes.
